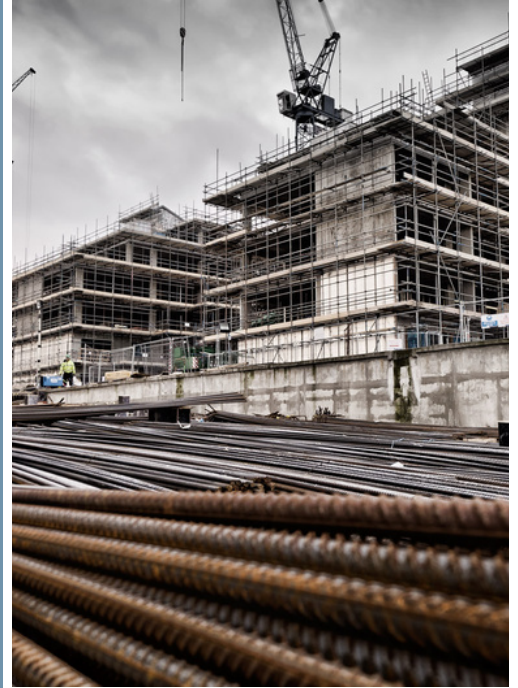

UNION CONTRACTORS COUNCIL

If you're signatory to one of the six crafts: Carpenters, Cement Masons, Ironworkers, Laborers, Operating Engineers, and/or Teamsters, then this council is for you. You and your teammates will be able to engage in quarterly meetings to discuss compliance and ongoing issues within our labor agreements, build stronger relationships with our union partners, and learn from peer-to-peer engagement. The Union Contractors Council (UCC) also establishes our craft committees and negotiation committees to engage, influence, negotiate, and ratify our master labor agreements and provides ongoing maintenance to ensure the contractors voice is heard in future negotiations. AGC of California has two UCC's to support our different agreements geographically with our crafts.

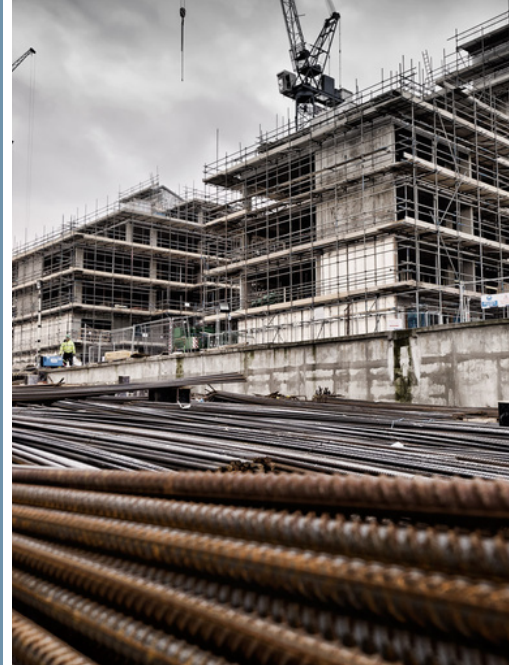

SCHOLARSHIPS

AGC is proud to award scholarships to individuals enrolled in certified training, pre-apprenticeship, or craft apprenticeship programs, and those attending two- or four-year college degree programs.

CLIC Scholarship: The California Landscape Irrigation Council (CLIC) Inc. Scholarship awards \$1,000 to a student who portrays academic excellence working towards a degree in: landscape construction, contracting, engineering, construction management, business administration, and/or related fields. The scholarship is also open to members of union trades specific to landscape careers. The applicant must be a resident of Southern California. The deadline to apply is April 5, 2024.

Marina Landscape Scholarship: Awarded to students who portray academic excellence working towards a degree in: landscape construction, engineering, construction management, business administration, and/or related fields. The scholarship is also open to members of union trades specific to landscape careers. The deadline to apply is April 5, 2024.

AGC College Scholarship: Awards individual scholarships ranging from \$500 – \$5,000. This is a great opportunity for college students pursuing construction or construction-related careers who are enrolled in a two- or four-year degree program. The deadline to apply is April 5, 2024.

AGC CEF Skilled Trades Scholarship: This scholarship is designed to support students pursuing post-secondary construction industry training programs. Scholarship amounts range from \$500-\$2,500. Students enrolled in or have been accepted to a pre-apprenticeship, apprenticeship or certified construction program are eligible. The deadline to apply is April 5, 2024.
