Casey has held the position of Chief Engineering and Program Delivery Officer since September 2019 at VTA reporting to General Manager/CEO Carolyn Gonot.

In this capacity, Casey is responsible for the Engineering & Program Delivery Division comprised of six departments staffed by an integrated team of about 120 agency and consultant staff. The departments are responsible for the development of capital projects and programs at VTA covering public transit, public transit facilities, bike/ped facilities, highways, express lanes, wildlife crossings and bicycle/pedestrian facilities. Two significant programs under Casey's responsibility are VTA's Silicon Valley Express Lanes Program and the Sustainability Program that is implementing actions for the agency's climate action and adaptation plan.

Casey received a Bachelor of Science degree in civil engineering from the University of Alaska, Fairbanks; and moved to California to attend graduate school and earned his Master of Science degree in civil engineering from the University of California at Berkeley.

Casey is a registered civil engineer in California and Alaska.
