Alex has over 28 years of experience in facility management, general contracting of major public/private projects, public/commercial maintenance and operations services, construction management, and public/private design/sustainability program management. He has successfully managed and recovered projects for the Department of Defense, Department of Transportation, healthcare, hospitality, K-12 education, community colleges, and universities.

Prior to being recruited to Fresno Unified School District, Alex was hired as Assistant Director of Maintenance and Operations as a recovery specialist to address and improve maintenance and operations related to safety, productivity, and quality control at Anchorage School District. Alex is a licensed general contractor in the State of Alaska, holds a PM Certification from Parsons Brinckerhoff/Harvard online, qualified at a GS-11 Principal Supervising Construction Coordinator for Department of Defense, and is a journeyman carpenter.
