Aaron Azevedo, P.E. is Director, State of Good Repair at Metrolink in Southern California. He has over 22 years of experience focusing on transportation infrastructure projects, including the assessment, development, funding, and delivery of State of Good Repair capital programs; he currently manages Metrolink's 25-year Rehabilitation Plan which documents Metrolink's backlog and annual funding needs in coordination with Metrolink's Transit Asset Management plan.

Aaron also manages a staff of Project Managers, Construction managers and field staff in the delivery of State of Good Repair improvements for Metrolink's 546 mile system and is currently responsible for delivering over 70 projects valued at over \$300M. Aaron lead the recently completed Los Angeles Union Station Rehabilitation and Modernization project, which was selected by the Construction Management Association of America as the top transportation project in the country for 2024.

Aaron is also leading the replacement of San Juan Creek Bridge in San Juan Capistrano in partnership with OCTA. Aaron has a BS in Civil Engineering, from CalPoly, San Luis Obispo, and is a licensed Professional Civil Engineer in the state of California.
