AWARDS & ELIGIBILITY

In reviewing the award categories, please note the following:

- It is not a requirement that the individual awards be presented annually.
- Eligibility requirements vary by award.

EXCELLENCE IN SKILL, INTEGRITY & RESPONSIBILITY AWARD

This award honors Skill, Integrity and Responsibility. To be eligible, the individual member may be from the public or private sector and must have made an outstanding contribution to California's construction industry. No employee or member of the association shall be eligible for the S.I.R. Award.

SUPPLIER/SERVICE PROVIDER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award recognizes outstanding AGC of California Supplier/Service Provider Members whose dedication, leadership, and service have made a lasting impact on California's construction industry. To be eligible, a Supplier/Service Provider Member must have been engaged in providing a product or service to the construction industry for a minimum of 15 years and be a member in good standing or member-in-retirement. SPECIALTY CONTRACTOR ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award recognizes the significant contributions to AGC of California and the construction industry by individual member specialty contractors. To be eligible, a person must have worked in the construction industry for a minimum of 15 years, be a member in good standing or a member-in-retirement of the AGC of California and be held in esteem by their peers. No Past President of the AGC of California shall be eligible for this award.

CONTRACTOR ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award recognizes the significant contributions to AGC of California and the construction industry by individual member contractors. To be eligible, a person must have worked in the construction industry for a minimum of 25 years, be a member in good standing or a member-in-retirement of the AGC of California and be held in esteem by their peers. No Past President of the AGC of California shall be eligible for this award.

NOMINATION PROCESS

In reviewing the nomination process for each award, please note that the nomination process varies by award. No one Board or Committee/Council may nominate more than one person per year. Eligible nominations will consist of a completed nomination form (enclosed) and a one-page narrative outlining the various achievements of the nominee and the reasons the nominee merits consideration for the award.

EXCELLENCE IN SKILL, INTEGRITY & RESPONSIBILITY AWARD

A person may be nominated by an individual member, the Executive Committee, the State Board of Directors, District Leaders, or Division, Committee & Council Leadership.

SUPPLIER/SERVICE PROVIDER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

A Supplier/Service Provider Member may be nominated by an individual member, the Executive Committee, the State Board of Directors, District Leaders, or Division, Committee & Council Leadership. No one Board or Committee/ Council may nominate more than one person per year.

CONTRACTOR & SPECIALTY CONTRACTOR AWARDS

A Contractor Member or Specialty Contractor member may be nominated by an individual member, the Executive Committee, the State Board of Directors, District Leaders, or Division, Committee & Council Leadership.

JUDGING PROCESS

In reviewing the judging process for each award, please be aware the judging panel and process varies by award.

SUPPLIER/SERVICE PROVIDER & S.I.R. ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

A panel of judges made up of the Vice President from each of the AGC of California Building, Highway & Transportation, and Utilities & Infrastructure; the Vice President of Specialty Contractors; the Supplier/Service Provider Representative and one member of the Awards Committee shall review the nominations for both categories and vote to select the recipients.

CONTRACTOR & SPECIALTY CONTRACTOR AWARDS

A panel of judges made up of three or more past presidents of AGC of California shall review the nominations for both award categories and vote to select the recipients.
